**Minutes of the 77<sup>th</sup> State Level Single Window Clearance Authority (SLSWCA) meeting held on 22/03/2018 at 03.30 PM in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Conference hall of Odisha Secretariat.**

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The meeting was chaired by the Chief Secretary, Odisha. The list of members present is annexed.

CMD, IPICOL, welcomed the chairperson and other participants.

At first, the status report on the usage of GO SWIFT portal by various departments was presented along with the demonstration of dashboards of Principal Secretary Labour and Chief Secretary. It was apprised that customised dashboards have been created for all concerned officials to ease the monitoring process and improve transparency. CS advised all departments to make use of the portal to ensure expeditious and time bound clearance of all applications. Besides, the departments need to ensure that all applications are routed through GO SWIFT for effective utilisation of the portal and online monitoring through respective dashboards. In particular, Energy and OSPCCB were advised to instruct all concerned to adhere to the instructions.

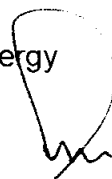

After detailed discussions, SLSWCA recommended the proposal of the company to HLCA, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The company will develop a downstream aluminium park to encourage the downstream and ancillary units in the state.
2. The company will clear arrear dues, if any, of any Government Department before allotment of land for the project
3. No raw material linkage / assurances from the State Govt. for the project shall be provided
4. The project should not be located on mineral bearing area or command area of any irrigation project.
5. The company will submit detail land use plan. Allotment of land to the project is subject to assessment by IPICOL (considering the bench mark report where ever available) or as required by the company, whichever is lower. The company will follow the prescribed procedure of IDCO for final allotment.
6. The allocation of water quantity is subject to assessment by IPICOL (considering the bench mark report where ever available) or as required by the company, whichever is lower and as per norms of DoWR/IDCO.

**AGENDA ITEM NO: 7**

**Proposal of M/s Shahi Exports Private Ltd. to change its expansion of Garment manufacturing unit at Mancheswar Industrial Estate, Bhubaneswar, to a new unit M/s Shahi Exports Private Ltd. (Odisha-2) with a revised total investment of Rs.51.00 crore.**

M/s Shahi Exports has successfully implemented an apparel manufacturing unit at Mancheswar Industrial Estate, Bhubaneswar to produce 36 lakh. pcs. per annum with an investment of Rs.36.40 crores and the same was inaugurated on 01.12.2016. Owing to the attractive ecosystem and the facilitation provided in the state, the company has decided to increase the capacity. However, the prevailing Odisha Apparel Policy, 2016, does not extend any incentives in case of expansion. Besides, an expansion project is ineligible for ED exemption and interest subsidy under IPR-2015.

The company is the largest garment exporter in India and currently employs around 2,000 workforce in the Odisha unit in single-shift operation, more than 90% being female workers. The unit is likely to add another shift shortly which would double the

workforce. The proposed unit of the company will create further employment for 2000 persons, mainly women, which will double if double-shift is operated. The Committee also noted the fact that the company has a choice of other locations in the country, particularly Jharkhand, which extends much higher fiscal incentives to apparel manufacturers.

In order to retain the investment and provide employment avenues to skilled women workforce of the state, SLFC has approved the proposal of M/s Shahi Exports Private Ltd. to withdraw its proposal to expand the capacity of the existing garment manufacturing unit at Bhubaneswar and instead set up a new unit, viz., M/s Shahi Exports Private Ltd. (Odisha-2). The company has intimated that the construction work of the new unit will commence after receipt of approval of the SLSWCA.

SLSWCA ratified the decision of SLFC.

The representation of M/s JSW for a captive jetty may be examined by the Commerce and Transport Dept.


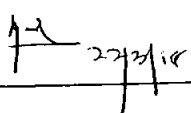
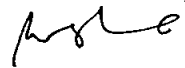
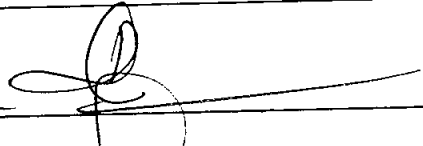


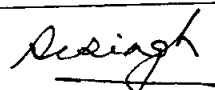
