Orissa Metalliks: Regarding the demerger of Railway Siding Project at Nayagarh, Keonjhar of M/s Rashmi Metaliks Ltd (RML) and transfer of the same to M/s Orissa Metaliks Private Ltd (OMPL), SLFC has discussed the views of NCLT and the Company Secretary(IPICOL) recommended the case for taking further Govt. approval along with forwarding the relevant documents to Steel & Mines Department for acceptance and providing NOC to transfer the Nayagarh Railway Siding Project from RML to OMPL. 4. TATA Global Beverages- SLFC has recommended the proposal to SLSWCA. 5. CDET- Site visit report was reviewed by the SLFC and it was observed that: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. there is no leasable Govt. land or habitation in and around the identified parcel at Village Dadari, Kaniha, ii. as there is no industrial land or infrastructure available, and no industrial development is at sight, the land may be not be suitable for any other industrial activity, iii. and land would be acquired privately by the company <p>Based on the above findings, SLFC has recommended the proposal to SLSWCA subject to the company taking all necessary precautions and statutory approvals from the concerned authorities.</p>

Falcon Marine- SLFC has accepted the sub-committee assessment of 0.0899 cusec of water and recommended the same to DoWR, based on the availability of water in the stated area. 12. Suraj Products- SLFC has accepted the sub-committee assessment of 0.57 cusec of water and recommended the same to DoWR. 13. Aditya Birla Fashion Retail- SLFC has recommend the case of transfer of the project in favour of Utkal Alumina Social Welfare Foundation (UASWF), which was earlier approved in favor of M/s Aditya Birla Fashion Retail Ltd(ABFRL), to SLSWCA, subject to the following conditions: i. The original configuration and timelines of the project remain intact. ii. The company to submit a copy of Board Resolution of ABFRL and UASWF for the transfer iii. The company to submit detailed explanation regarding formation of Section 8 Company. 14. Runaya- SLFC has accepted the request of the company for obtaining land from IDCO for their project, which is to be put up to SLSWCA. 15. Arcelor Mittal- Company to be asked to submit their firm plan for the Integrated Steel Plant, proposed to be set up at Paradeep.
