‘Make-in-India’ – reg.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to above, it is to inform that the Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP), Govt. of India has started an innovative programme named “Make in India” to strengthen the manufacturing industries and make it competitive in the global market. As part of this initiative, DIPP has circulated an action plan for all the States. This action plan is to be implemented in a time bound manner. One of the action points is to submit inspection report within 72 hours.


The matter was discussed during review meeting of compliance to action points under Make-in-India programme. It was opined that observation made during inspection with regards to different kinds of pollution is always related to discharge / emission of pollutants which requires field as well as laboratory analysis. Moreover, analysis of certain parameters requires more than five days time. Hence, it was decided that the inspecting officer can submit inspection report within 72 hours of completion of inspection where laboratory analysis report is not required and within 72 hours of completion of laboratory analysis where laboratory analysis report is required.

You are therefore instructed to look to the above aspects and henceforth submit Inspection Report to Head Office through on-line system within 72 hours of completion of the inspection where no analysis result is required and within 72 hours of completion of laboratory analysis where analysis result is required.
