Odisha Electricity (Duty) Act, 1961/ Section 5(1)/ 11797/ 30.11.2022

Earlier in the Odisha Electricity (Duty) Act, 1961 Section 5(1) imposed interest at 18% p.a. on the amount of electricity duty remaining so unpaid until payment thereof is made. Many captive consumers defaulted the payment over the years leading to huge arrears of electricity duty.

Resolution of the electricity duty and interest in respect of captive consumers through amicable settlement of the arrear electricity duty pending against captive consumers.

- In this settlement scheme interest would be charged at a reduced rate of 9% interest p.a. from 18% interest p.a. for those CPPs who want to avail the benefits of the scheme
- The OTS scheme shall be kept open for a limited period of 2 months from the date of issue of the operational guidelines by the concerned authorities of the State.
- Upon receiving the application, OTS shall be issued preferably within 2 months from the date of application indicating the settled amount to be paid and stipulating the period not exceeding 2 months in which payment is to be made.
